Information for Clubs – Winter 2010 Competition

The following is a summary of some Association By Laws, and is supplied for information only. A full copy of the By Laws, including penalties for infringements, is available for sighting from an Executive member.

- Teams may register a **minimum of eight** players and a **maximum of ten** players (juniors and intermediates) or **twelve** players (seniors)
- Junior players will be under the age of 13 years as at 31 December 2010
- Modified rules (Netta) are played for nine years and under division
- With the approval of the Coaching and Junior Convenors, a ten years player may be included in a Netta team if that player has not played netball before
- If junior teams have registered players present at their games, those players must play at least half a game
- Registration fees payable are based on the age of a player. For example, a 12 years player playing in an Intermediate team will pay the Junior fee.
- Players may play up one grade within their club but not down or across a division
- Junior players may play up one age division only
- No player is permitted to play in a competition match until they have paid all registration fees
- Intermediate players will be under the age of 16 years as at 31 December 2010
- Each team must have a minimum of five players in full uniform ready to take the court within one minute of the scheduled starting time, with score sheets correctly completed, or the opposing team is entitled to claim a forfeit.
- When seven or more players of the original team are present and able to play, subbing of other players is not permitted.
- Players are permitted to play with one club and be registered in one team only. With the exception that any Intermediate player may be registered in both Senior and Intermediate competitions within their own club. In this instance the Senior registration fee is payable.
- Once a player has played up for the same team three times they must play in the higher team and are not permitted to play in the lower team again
- If a player is deemed to be registered in a higher grade team after playing up three times, and this brings the number of registered players in the team to eleven (or thirteen in the case of seniors), then the team must deregister one player and that player may not play for the club again in the current competition.
- If a player has not taken the court at any time and their NSW netball fees have not yet been paid to Netball NSW, then at the discretion of the Treasurer and the Registrar, their fees may be transferred or refunded.
- Players must have played for their team a minimum of three times to be eligible to play in any finals game for that team
- Any team forfeiting a game must notify the relevant Convenor and opposing team not later than 5pm the day before the game.
- Teams will be subject to disqualification from the competition after three un-notified forfeits
- All players must wear full registered uniform after week three of the competition
